Merujuk kepada brafaks dari Kepala Perwakilan RI di Cairo, Mesir nomor B-00225/Cairo/260809 pada tanggal 9 Agustus 2026 perihal Penyampaian Informasi Tawaran Beasiswa dari Kemdikti dan Riset Republik Arab Mesir jenjang Sarjana (S1) dan Pascasarjana (S2 dan S3) Tahun Akademik 2026/2027 (non Al-Azhar), bersama ini disampaikan bahwa Kementerian Pendidikan Tinggi dan Riset, Mesir membuka pendaftaran beasiswa jenjang S1, S2, dan S3 pada portal EGYAID. Beasiswa ini ditujukan untuk studi di universitas-universitas Mesir (non Al-Azhar) serta beasiswa kelas bahasa Arab di Pusat Kebudayaan Mesir untuk pembelajaran bahasa Arab bagi penutur asing untuk tahun akademik 2026/2027.

Pendaftaran beasiswa dapat dilakukan melalui portal "Study in Egypt" yang dapat diakses melalui tautan berikut: <https://admission.study-in-egypt.gov.eg>. Sebagai informasi bahwa batas akhir pendaftaran beasiswa adalah tanggal 15 September 2026. Turut disampaikan terlampir salinan aturan pendaftaran dan linimasa beasiswa EGYAID sebagai panduan.

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**EGYAID Scholarships (Cultural Exchange – Subcommittee for International students
Ministry of Foreign Affairs) for the levels: Undergraduate , postgraduate students and
learning Arabic “At the Egyptian Centre for Teaching Arabic Language for non Native
speakers “**

1. According to the announced rules, the deadline for embassies to submit the lists of scholarship candidates is 15 August 2026.
2. Students should meet all eligibility criteria and admission requirements for the academic programs to which they are nominated under the scholarship at Egyptian universities.
3. Students should register via the EGYAID scholarship platform in accordance with the governing rules and regulations.
4. The deadline for submitting scholarship applications via the EGYAID scholarship platform is 15 September 2026.
5. A student who has previously applied via the electronic platform "Study in Egypt" in previous years at their own expense and has been enrolled at a university can not transfer their study status from self-funded to scholarship-funded, **except in some exceptional cases and after the approval of the competent authority.**
6. **A new student who applies via the "Study in Egypt" platform at their own expense and completes all required procedures is also eligible to apply through the EGYAID scholarship platform in the same academic year.**
7. The procedures for enrolling students under scholarships shall be completed until their security clearance is issued, if the student is rejected by the security authorities, the scholarship shall be revoked.
8. . A quota of 25% for each country shall be allocated to students applying for scholarships in the medical sector and the top faculties, excluding Nursing, Physiotherapy, Engineering, and Computer Sciences. This quota shall include scholarships offered through the Cultural Exchange Program and the Subcommittee for International students of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
9. Students nominated for scholarships are entitled to admission only to the regular departments at Egyptian universities. If they choose to enroll in a special fee-paying program, they will be required to pay the applicable tuition fees, just like any other student enrolled in the same program at his own expense.
10. **The approved scholarships are distributed among all universities in Egypt based on each university's capacity and the percentage of students admitted at their own expense.**
11. Students who have been approved by the Office of the Presidency shall not be nominated for scholarships or granted exemptions or reductions in fees and tuition charged to International students in foreign currency, except for scholarships provided to students of the Egyptian Agency of Partnership for Development - Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

12. Universities shall notify the Central administration for International students Affairs of any students brought in from their countries through cultural programs and agreements, Nile Basin scholarship, European Union projects and any scholarships offered by entities other than the Ministry of Higher Education scholarships from universities, training courses at universities' Arabic language centers or any short-term training. In addition, copies of the students' passports are required for approval by the competent authority
13. African students from Anglophone and Francophone countries who are nominated for scholarships shall be exempt from paying tuition fees in language departments in faculties at Egyptian governmental universities , except for fees to new programs, in accordance with the decision of the Supreme Council of Universities on 19/8/2017.
14. A university scholarship cannot be converted into a postgraduate scholarship, and a postgraduate scholarship cannot be converted into a university scholarship.
15. For the common good, a student's registration and scholarship may be postponed if the student has completed the scholarship registration process but is unable to attend or complete their studies due to reasons deemed acceptable by the competent authority in specific case , (in scholarship registration year)with exemption from paying postponement fees(as stipulated in the scholarship regulations.)
16. The scholarship will be cancelled if the nominated student does not benefit from it during the year of nomination, and it cannot be transferred to or replaced by another student.
17. The student on the scholarship shall pay the school expenses due for the years of failure.
18. The scholarship platform EGYAID does not include private or national universities
19. . If a postgraduate student does not benefit from the scholarship for a specific period (whether a full academic year or a semester), a statement regarding the student's status shall be submitted to the Administration of International Students Affairs at the Ministry of Higher Education, confirming that no fees are due from the student for that period. The student shall benefit from this period after the expiration of the scholarship period only upon obtaining the approval of the competent authority (as stipulated in the scholarship regulations)
20. "The Arabic language scholarship cannot be transferred into a undergraduate or postgraduate scholarship." (as stipulated in the scholarship regulations)
21. Students registered for a university scholarship who are non-native Arabic speakers may join the Arabic Language Learning Center in the year of their registration(as stipulated in the scholarship regulations),students register on the Arabic language scholarship platform, as only these students are exempted from the scholarship platform closing date and application fees.
22. The specialization of the academic degree may be modified in postgraduate scholarship applications submitted through the EYAID scholarship platform, provided that the student submits an official approval letter from the faculty confirming acceptance of the modification. The requested change will then be processed through the website's technical support team.
23. Amending the nomination of scholarship students whose application is submitted during the year of registration to another university . If the student submits his original documents to the university or the administration, he have to issue a case statement from the university confirming that his registration procedures have not yet been completed. This applies only in exceptional cases and requires approval from the competent authority.

24. File withdrawal fees will not be collected or claimed from scholarship students who have not completed the registration procedures, have not benefited from the scholarship, and wish to withdraw the file
25. If a registered student who has benefited from the scholarship wishes to withdraw his file (the original documents), he should submit a recently issued academic status statement from his faculty and pay the fees for the file withdrawal service,, the administration will issue the student an official letter authorizing him to withdraw his file from the university.(in accordance with the approval of "His Excellency the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research ", dated December 18, 2025.)
26. A student's excuse for not attending an exam may be accepted, provided that it has been approved by the relevant faculty or institute. In such cases, the academic year shall not be counted as a year of scholarship failure. This exemption may be granted only once during the student's entire period of study. This provision applies to students who were awarded scholarships in the academic years **2023/2024**, **2024/2025**, and **2025/2026**.
27. Students who are registered for university scholarships and have successfully completed their studies may apply for a scholarship to pursue the next higher academic level (postgraduate studies)

Scholarship Application Requirements

- The student who has been nominated for the scholarship for the university year 202^٦/202^٧ has to be academically superior and meets the minimum requirement
- Maximum age (٢٢ university grades - ٣٠ years master's degree - 32 doctorates).
- Submitting a research proposal for postgraduate students.
- Submitting the documents required for registration
- Writing a good personal speech.
- Submit curriculum vitae, and a recommendation letter.

For students applying for the Arab Language Cultural Center:

- Students should be capable of successfully passing the preparatory level as a beginner.
- The maximum age limit for applicants is 32 years.
- Placement Test is held online or in person at the Arab Language Cultural Center.

Basic Criteria for Selecting Scholarship applicants/candidates

- Priority for students who applied via EGYAID scholarship platform.
- Priority for those with the highest grades
- Priority for younger age.
- Priority for those who obtain their High School Certificates from their countries.
- For postgraduate studies priority is for those who have approval to study from an Egyptian university, or a foreign university with a high ranking.

Reasons for termination or reducing the scholarship (unless the student has a compelling excuse approved by the faculty consul):

- The student does not register the maximum number of required academic courses each semester in accordance with the requirements of the specialization.
- A student who has previously been awarded a scholarship (which was subsequently terminated, suspended, or withdraw his file) shall not be eligible to apply for another scholarship in any subsequent academic year.
- The scholarship shall be suspended if the student fails. In such cases, the student shall be required to pay 100% of the tuition fees for the academic year following the year of failure. The scholarship shall be fully reinstated upon the student's successful completion of the academic year or promotion to the next academic year, provided that the student submits proof of payment of the tuition fees for the academic year in which the failure occurred.
- If the student is convicted of a felony or a misdemeanor involving dishonorable conduct.
